EXCITING THINGS PLANNED

As well as turning part of our classroom into a rainforest, we'll be hosting a debate on deforestation. To celebrate the end of our topic we'll be enjoying a Rainforest party.

Literacy

This term will we be looking at stories from other cultures. We will read The Tiger Child by Joanna Troughton and Seasons of Splendour by Madhur Jaffrey. We'll be writing our own Indian folk tale.

Numeracy

In numeracy we will be focusing on shapes and revisiting measurement. We will look at 2d and 3d shapes, angles, lines, coordinates and translations. In measurement we will go on time and converting units of measure.
