Today we have been raising money for Children in Need. Thank you to all the children for donating money in exchange for coming to school in non-uniform...of mostly the spotty type.

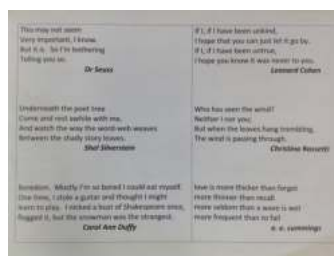
The school council sold spotty biscuits at break time for 50p and the total money raised was a staggering **£158.48.**

Thank you also to Mrs Norrington for helping the school council organise this event.

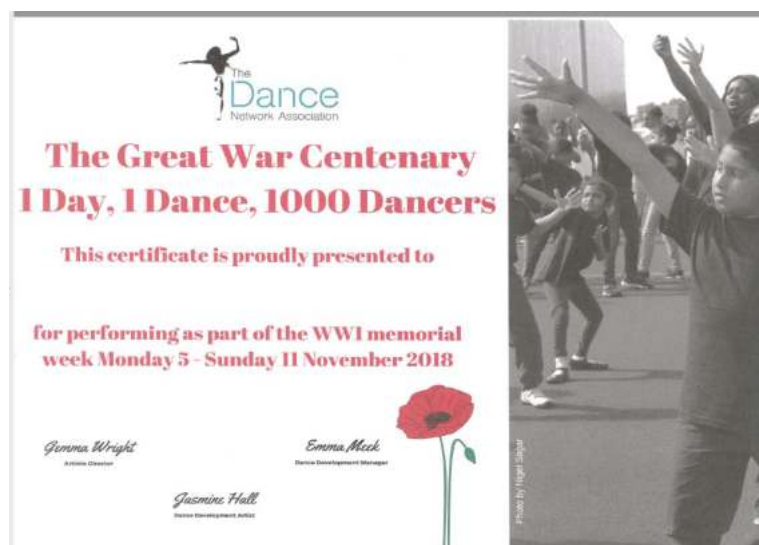


Tango With Poetry
