Holidays in Term Time

We would like to remind all Parents/Carers that we will not authorise holidays during term time unless the reasons are exceptional.

Penalty notices may be issued where there has been at least 10 sessions of unauthorised absence during the previous ten school weeks.

The penalty for each parent is £60, for each child, if paid within 21 days of receipt of the notice. This rises to £120 if paid after 21 days but within 28 days of receipt of the notice.


