English

In English, we will be writing narratives, including flash-backs, non-chronological reports of imaginary animals, diary entries and letters. We will be focusing on learning and using the KS2 statutory spellings.

We will be reading the book 'Viking boy' for guided reading.

RE

Our big questions this half-term will be: How do beliefs shape identity for Buddhists?

In summer 2, the big question will be: How has belief in Hinduism impacted on music and art throughout history?

PE - In PE, we will be learning to play rounders in summer 1 and swimming in summer 2, as well as continuing with tennis lessons..

Computing

In computing, the children will be creating an adventure based game in summer 1 and creating spreadsheets in summer 2.

Science

We will be learning about the different forces, including gravity and completing research on Isaac Newton. We will complete investigations on the effect of different forces

Humanities

In history, we will learn about the Vikings, their lives, invasions and settlements.

In geography, Countries Vikings came from and explain similarities and differences between Scandinavia and UK.

In art, we will be creating pop art and learning why it was so influential.

Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on decimals, percentages and fractions before moving onto ratio and algebra.
