PE

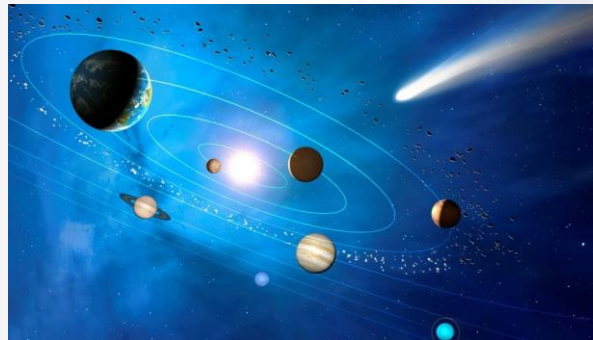
In PE, we will be beginning dance.
